What information we collect & what we use it for

All personal information that we collect about you will be recorded, used, and protected by us in accordance with applicable data protection legislation and this privacy policy. We may supplement the information that you provide with other information that we obtain from our dealings with you. The following are examples, although not exhaustive, of how we collect your personal information:

What are your rights?
